CHURCH AND BELL TOWER

THE SQUARES

Piazza Cermenati and Piazza XX settembre are the heart of the city, sorrounded by residential buildings. You can visit the Palazzo delle Paure and walk until Piazza Manzoni to see the statue of the famous writer.



THE TOWER

This only remain of the fortifications is a quadrangular tower of the XIV century. It is in a corner of piazza XX settembre. On the first floor you can see some temporary exhibitions.



## THE LAKESIDE

You can walk along the lakeside so as not to miss the golden statue of San Nicolò in the lake, the floating platform and the war monument. Relax for some minutes on a bench to enjoy the landscape
